Up to 50 people can now attend Mass, Baptisms, funerals or private prayer in church, following social distancing rules and 20 at weddings. Parishes must ensure that their churches are not left unattended when their doors are open and must keep written records (for at least four weeks) with the names and contact details of everyone who comes into church at any time. **Catholics have been asked to register their attendance at church via www.massregister.com.au.** If a confirmed case of the virus occurs in a parish, every person who registered as an attendee of the parish will receive an email notifying them of the diagnosis and the date and time the infected person attended church. No other details will be provided.

Please use **sanitiser** from the foyer dispensers. Please check **your details** are recorded. If you have not phoned ahead, you will have to record your details. There must be **no** more than 50 people at a Mass. Please sit where there is a white sticker on the pew back in front of you.

We are not permitted congregational singing. There must be no handshakes at the Sign of Peace, only the words. There will be no receiving Holy Communion from the chalice or on the tongue. No Offertory procession. Collection plates are not passed. We must keep social distance at all times, even when coming to Communion.

Every morning (7 days) our Church will be open for this from **8 to 9 a.m.**

Always there is a maximum of 50 present, who must register their details.

RECONCILIATION (*Confession & Forgiveness*). Our priest is available in the Reconciliation Room Tuesday and Thursday from 6.30 to 6.55 p.m. (before 7 p.m. Mass). He can also be approached for Reconciliation during private prayer times (every day 8 to 9 a.m. & 5 to 6 p.m.).
