Please only sit where there is a white sticker on the back of the pew in front of you. Please come as far forward as possible in Church

We are not permitted congregational singing (not even the Alleluia). There must be no handshakes at the Sign of Peace, only the words. There will be no receiving Holy Communion from the chalice. Holy Communion can only be received in the hand not on the tongue. There is no Offertory procession. Collection plates are not passed. Keep social distance at all times, even when coming to Communion.
