### **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION**

Year 3 children or older at any school are eligible, provided they have begun receiving Reconciliation (Confession). We will continue with the arrangements already decided **Enrolment Evenings** for parents to enroll children in preparation: **for all fathers: Sun. Sept. 13** **for all mothers: Sun. Sept. 20** Parents meet **6.45 pm** in Church but please don't bring children.

The details of each child's Baptism (Christening) will be needed.

**CONFIRMATION.** Year 6 students or older are eligible. We will know soon if and when this will take place here, during this pandemic.

**RECONCILIATION** (for Year 2 and older) is deferred till early next year.
