BACKGROUND TO THE FIRST READING. The first attempts of St. Paul *(still using his Jewish name Saul)* to be a Christian missionary. It follows his conversion and call from God to be an apostle to the wider world. *Hellenists* mentioned were those whose culture & language were Greek.

BACKGROUND TO THE GOSPEL. In Eastertide, we listen to the talk Jesus gave at the Last Supper, because it is like his 'last will and testament' before his Passover of death, resurrection and ascension.

MASS COUNT. The Conference of Australian Bishops have required that there be counts of people taking part in our Sunday Masses (including Saturday evenings) over the first four weekends of May. The first two will only involve counting the number of people present but the third weekend will involve counting the number of males and females; the fourth weekend will involve counting the people present according to five categories of their ages: 0–17, 18-29, 30-49, 50–69, 70+. Pastoral Council members will make every effort to count in ways that do not intrude on people's privacy and do not disturb the prayer of Mass

ADULT CONFIRMATIONS: This Sacrament will be administered to adults at the Cathedral on Pentecost Sunday 23rd May at 10.30 a.m. Mass. If any adult here has not been Confirmed please our priest Brother Pat now.

CHILDREN'S SACRAMENTS Children' first receiving of Reconciliation and Communion: Children in Years 2 and 3 will be eligible for Reconciliation and children in Year 3 will also be eligible for Holy Communion.
