FIRST READING TODAY. In a very primitive sacrifice and blood ceremony, Moses officially celebrated what we call the **old Covenant** (Testament), the loving contract which bound God and Israelites (the Jewish people) together

SECOND READING. Christ's perfect sacrifice brings a **new Covenant** which bound God and humanity together. This letter was written to reassure Jewish Christians that when they moved from Temple worship and its sacrifices they went to something so much more powerful in Jesus, the Messiah, the Christ.

THE THREAT TO CATHOLIC METROPOLITAN CEMETERIES TRUST: CMCT

There are 4 cemetery operators in Sydney, responsible for burials, not funerals. A State Gov. review found that the 3 non-Catholic operators had no more capacity for burials, had not built up funds for maintenance of graves, and had overall a 300 million dollar shortfall. Whereas the Catholic Trust had enough funds for maintenance & for new graves for at least 50 years. It also had funds, land and Council consents for new cemeteries at Varroville and Wallacia. Our Trust conducts burials not only for Catholics, also for other Christians, and those of Islamic and Jewish faiths and all are happy with the ways our Trust respects their practices. Instead of dealing with the problems of the non-Catholic operators (which our Trust could help with) the State Gov. decided to abolish **all** operators and create a Government operator. They intend to use the funds built up by our Catholic Trust. **It is nothing more than an immoral cash grab!** The funds were given, mainly by Catholics, for the upkeep of graves of their departed.
