FIRST READING TODAY: The Books: EZRA and NEHEMIAH in the Old Testament deal with the time when, fifty years after being conquered by Babylon, some Jews from 538 BC on gradually returned to Jerusalem from exile. Ezra was religious leader and Nehemiah Governor during the restoration. **THE LAW** that is mentioned in today's reading would be early Old Testament, perhaps the Book of Deuteronomy.

SECOND: On the road to Damascus, Paul was converted from being a violent persecutor of the Church. Jesus said to him "Why are you persecuting me?" From then on, Paul saw an identity between Jesus and the Church - as in today's reading.

GOSPEL. This Church year in Ordinary Sundays we will be reading St. Luke's account of the Gospel. Today we read the first paragraph of it. Then we jump 3 chapters to where Jesus goes back to Galilee after his Baptism and desert retreat.
