REFLECTIONS ON CHRISTIAN BAPTISM (CHRISTENING).

In this Sacrament God brings a person into the family of Jesus, the Church, by sharing the life of Jesus with the Baptized. Jesus called Baptism "being **born again** through water and the Holy Spirit" - a new birth because a new life starts in us, a share the life and Spirit of Jesus. This new life washes away all sins: all personal sins and the Original Sin.

INFANT BAPTISM. Catholics, like the Orthodox, and many other Christians, believe Jesus welcomes little children into his life by Baptism when parents who have faith in Him bring children to the Church. Here Baptism of infants takes place normally on Sundays at 11.30 a.m. (sometimes though it can happen in Mass when couples involved in the Parish and in that Mass request this). Because of the pandemic, there is a backlog of infants' Baptisms, so other times may be needed. To arrange Baptisms please ring our Parish Secretary (9825 8154)

ADULTS are Baptized normally at Easter, after a group preparation called Catechumenate **or RCIA** (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). This takes several months but the time may vary depending on the readiness and the needs of the adults who are involved. However, with permission, an adult's Baptism can take place when a person is prepared.



THE FILIPINO FEAST OF THE HOLY NAZARENE will be celebrated here this Sunday 9th January. The devotion of many Filipinos to Jesus in his sufferings is shown through veneration of a lifesized image of a dark, kneeling Jesus carrying the Cross.
