FIRST READING TOAY. Abraham, about 1800 BC, had to fight to rescue his nephew Lot. Returning from battle, Abraham met a priest who was also pagan king of a place later called **Jeru- Salem.** The bread and wine, which perhaps was sacrificed, made this incident a sign in advance of the Eucharist.

SECOND READING. In this passage, we believe that Paul gives the earliest written account that we have of the institution of the Eucharist (the Mass)
