FIRST READING THIS WEEKEND. The books of Maccabees were written to stimulate the faith of Jews when they were struggling against Syrian conquerors about 150 BC. They show a firm belief in a future resurrection, life after death, among many Jewish people at that time.

GOSPEL READING. A group of hard-headed men from a very conservative society of Jewish priests, called Sadducees, and who did not believe in any resurrection, asked Jesus a mocking question about life after death.

CHILDREN'S & YOUNGSTERS' RECEPTION OF SACRAMENTS 2023

1. FIRST RECEIVING OF RECONCILIATION (confession and forgiveness). Children of the Parish in at least Year 3 in any school can be prepared for this. Church law requires children must have begun receiving Reconciliation before being eligible to begin receiving Communion.

2. FIRST RECEIVING OF HOLY COMMUNION IN 2023

Children of the Parish in at least **Year 3** in any school can be prepared for this provided they have already begun receiving Reconciliation..

3. CONFIRMATION 2023 will take place in **St. Mary's Cathedral** in the last quarter of 2023 for young members of ten Parishes of this area. Candidates need to be **Baptised**, to have received **Reconciliation** and **Communion** and are in at least in Year **6** or in **High School** in 2023. We plan to have coaches from here to our magnificent Mother Church where our Archbishop & his Assistant Bishops will administer Confirmation.
