## MASS TIMES FOR THE LORD'S DAY IN GOOD SHEPHERD PARISH SATURDAY 5.30 P.M. SUNDAY 8 A.M. 10 A.M. 5.30 P.M.

IN THE FIRST READING Galilee is the area where Jesus lived & where he started preaching. Galilee is also called the land of Zebulun & Naphtali (two of the sons of the Patriarch Jacob and so are names of two of the 12 Tribes). Galilee is in the North of Palestine, just below Lebanon, and is bordered in the West by the Sea of Galilee & Jordan River. It was also called Province of the Nations because of its mixed population, being a commercial crossroads. In Jesus' time, some in Israel looked down on Galilee and those who lived there because of its mixed races.

**SECOND READING**. Paul stayed 18 months in Corinth, starting and building up the Church. So, safter he left he was upset to learn the Church there was in danger of splitting into opposing groups, based on different Church leaders. **Cephas** is the Hebrew word for Rock or Peter. **Apollos** was a well-educated, cultured Jewish convert to Christianity.


GOSPEL: St. Matthew's account of the start of Jesus' saving work in Galilee.
