GOOD SHEPHERD PARISH CHILDREN'S SACRAMENTS 2023

- 1. FIRST RECEIVING OF RECONCILIATION (Confession & Forgiveness) Children of the Parish in Year 3 or a higher class in any school can be prepared for this. Church law requires children must have begun receiving Reconciliation before eligible to begin receiving Communion. ENROLMENT EVENINGS when parents include children in the preparation: for all Catholic fathers: Saturday Feb. 11th 2023 at 6.45 p.m. in Church. for all Catholic mothers: Sunday Feb.12th 2023 at 6.45 p.m. in Church. Parents who are not Catholic are very welcome. The meetings are definitely not for the children and will take place in the Church after the 5.30 p.m. Mass. The child's Baptism Certificate is needed, unless the Baptism took place here. FIRST RECEIVING OF RECONCILIATION Sunday 26th March at 12 or 2 p.m.
- 2.. CONFIRMATION. Young members of our Parish who are in Year 6 in in 2023 any school or who are in any High School are eligible. These Candidates need to have been Baptised and to have begun receiving Reconciliation and Holy Communion. Because the Confirmations will take place in our beautiful Mother Church: St. Mary's Cathedral in the city, we plan for the Candidates, their Sponsors and parents to have coaches from here to the Cathedral where our Archbishop Anthony and Assistant Bishops will administer Confirmation. ENROLMENT when parents can include their youngsters in the preparation: for all Catholic fathers: Saturday May 6th 2023 at 6.45 pm in Church. for all Catholic mothers: Sunday May 7th 2023 at 6.45 at 6.45 pm in Church. Baptism, Reconciliation, Communion Certificates not needed if youngsters received these Sacraments in Good Shepherd Church. Otherwise, they are.
- 3. FIRST RECEIVING OFCOMMUNION. Children of the Parish in at least Year 3 in any school can be prepared,, provided they have received Reconciliation. ENROLMENT EVENINGS when parents include children in the preparation for all Catholic fathers: Sat. October 14th 2023 at 6.45 p.m. in Church for all Catholic mothers: Sun.October 15th 2023 at 6.45 p.m. in Church As always parents who are not Catholics are very welcome to the Enrolments Each child's Baptism & Reconciliation Certificate needed, unless from here. First Communion will be on Nov. 25 / 26 Feast of Christ the King 2023.
