THE PERMANENT DIACONATE. . "Deacon" comes from the Greek word diakonia meaning "servant." The Acts of the Apostles describes how men "of good reputation, filled with the Spirit and with wisdom" were chosen as deacons to assist the Apostles in caring for the poor and proclaiming the Gospel. Through the centuries, deacons have served the Church by exercising the ministry of charity in close cooperation with the bishop. In 1964 the Vatican Council renewed the ancient order of the permanent diaconate, distinct from transitional deacons preparing for Priesthood. Like a priest, a permanent deacon is a member of the clergy who shares in the ministry of the bishop. Unlike a priest, he may also have a wife, a family & secular occupation. This deacon is a permanent sign of Christ the Servant.

Our Archbishop, Anthony Fisher, has given great honour to our Parish by choosing and calling to the Permanent Diaconate for the Archdiocese of Sydney our involved and generous parishioner TIVOLI VAIOTU. As ever Tiv has generously responded and now has begun the studies and other preparation. We are grateful that his wife, Peta, also involved in so much here, has supported him, as we must do with our prayers.
