FIRST READING TODAY. Leviticus is thought to be the work of many hands, adapting the Law of Moses to later needs. Today's **Gospel:** our Lord's teaching of universal love in the Sermon on the Mount starts from Leviticus.

SECOND READING. St. Paul is combating disunity in the Church in Corinth where factions aligned themselves with different Church leaders. Paul says that damaging our Christian community is like vandalising a sacred place.



THIS WEDNESDAY is Ash Wednesday which begins LENT, a season of prayer, self-denial, generosity, leading to Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter.

In Catholic Church law, Ash Wednesday (like Good Friday) is a day of **some fasting from food and drink** (for Catholics aged 18 to 60 years) and also a day of **abstaining from meat** (for Catholics aged 14 and older).

There will be **2 Masses here** with distribution of ashes: **one at 9 a.m**. with Good Shepherd Primary Schoolchildren, teachers, parents and other parishioners and another Ash Wednesday Mass for all parishioners who can attend **at 7 p.m**.

PROJECT COMPASSION supports Caritas (Australian Catholic Relief Overseas Aid) in its work for the poor in developing areas and among those in distress because of war & disasters. Our priest asks adults to use **Project Compassion envelopes**, trying to give a fixed amount for each of Lent's 40 days. Children and pensioners are asked to use **Project Compassion boxes**. Any donations of \$2 and over to Project Compassion are tax-deductible.
