THE PERMANENT DIACONATE. In 1964 the Vatican Council renewed this ancient order distinct from **transitional** deacons preparing for the priesthood. Like a priest, a permanent deacon is a member of the clergy who shares in the ministry of the bishop. Unlike a priest, he may also have a wife, family & secular occupation. Our deacons are permanent helpers in the Cathedral and in whichever parishes they are appointed to. Our Archbishop has given a great honour to our Parish by choosing & calling our generous parishioner Tivoli Vaiotu to prepare for the Permanent Diaconate for our Archdiocese.

THE WAY OF THE CROSS (THE STATIONS) will be prayed in our Church at 6 p.m. on each of the Fridays in Lent. This year though ON GOOD FRIDAY because Tivoli will be occupied with so many responsibilities and his new calling, we will not be able to have the dramatic presentation of the WAY OF THE CROSS by the youth of the of the Parish. We will instead have at 11 a.m. guided meditations of STATIONS OF THE CROSS in the Church for all the parishioners who can attend.
