FIRST READING TODAY. About 11200 B.C. the Chosen people in the desert of Sinai failed to trust God in their difficulties. God through Moses then worked the miracle of providing water for them. The place famously became known as MASSAH which means A BURDEN. When burdened with the desert setting the Hebrews CONTENDED (grumbled) against God. This what MERIBAH means.
