

GOOD SHEPHERD CATHOLIC PARISH CHILDREN'S SACRAMENTS 2023

We had to change the arrangements; sorry about that.

Because CONFIRMATION in St. Mary's Cathedral may happen much earlier than we previously were told we will need to have the enrolment and preparation during the second term of the school year in 2023 and so had to move Communion to the 4th term.

1. FIRST RECEIVING OF RECONCILIATION (Confession & Forgiveness)

Children of the Parish in Year 3 or a higher class in any school can be prepared for this. Church law requires children must have begun receiving Reconciliation before eligible to begin receiving Communion.

ENROLMENT EVENING when parents enrol children in the parish preparation is.

For all parents: Saturday Aug. 12th 2023 at 6.45 p.m.

Parents who are not Catholic are also welcome. The meetings are definitely not for the children and will take place in the Church after 5.30 p.m. mass. The child's **Baptism Certificate** is needed, unless the Baptism took place here.

The first receiving of Reconciliation will be on **Saturday 16th Sept.** in two sessions: at **12.30 p.m.** and at **2 p.m.**

2. CONFIRMATION

Children in Year 6 in any school or in any High School are eligible. Candidates need to be **Baptised**, to have received **Reconciliation** and **Holy Communion** and are in at least **Year 6** or in **High School** in 2023.

We plan to have coaches from here to our magnificent Mother Church where Archbishop & his Assistant Bishops will administer Confirmation.

ENROLMENT EVENINGS when parents enrol children in the parish for preparation
for all Catholic fathers: Saturday May 6th 2023 6.45 p.m.

for all Catholic mothers: Sunday May 7th 2023 6.45 p.m.

Each child's Baptism, Reconciliation, Communion Certificates are needed, unless they took place in Good Shepherd Church

3. FIRST RECEIVING OF HOLY COMMUNION. Children of the Parish in at least **Year 3** in any school can be prepared for this, provided they have already begun receiving Reconciliation.

ENROLMENT EVENINGS when parents enrol children in the parish preparation are

For all Catholic fathers: Saturday Oct. 14th 2023 6.45 p.m.

for all Catholic mothers: Sunday Oct. 15th 2023 6.45 p.m.

Parents who are not Catholic are also welcome if their child is Catholic. Each child's Baptism & Reconciliation Certificate are needed, unless already sighted or from Good Shepherd Church.

First Communion will be received on the weekend of the Feast of Christ the King November 25th / 26th 2023.
