LENT BEGINS THIS WEDNESDAY

ASH WEDNESDAY begins LENT, the Church season of prayer, self-discipline, reconciliation and generosity, leading to Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter. In Catholic Church law, Ash Wednesday (like Good Friday) is a day of some fasting from food and drink (for Catholics aged 18 to 60 years) and also a day of abstaining from meat (for Catholics aged 14 and older).
